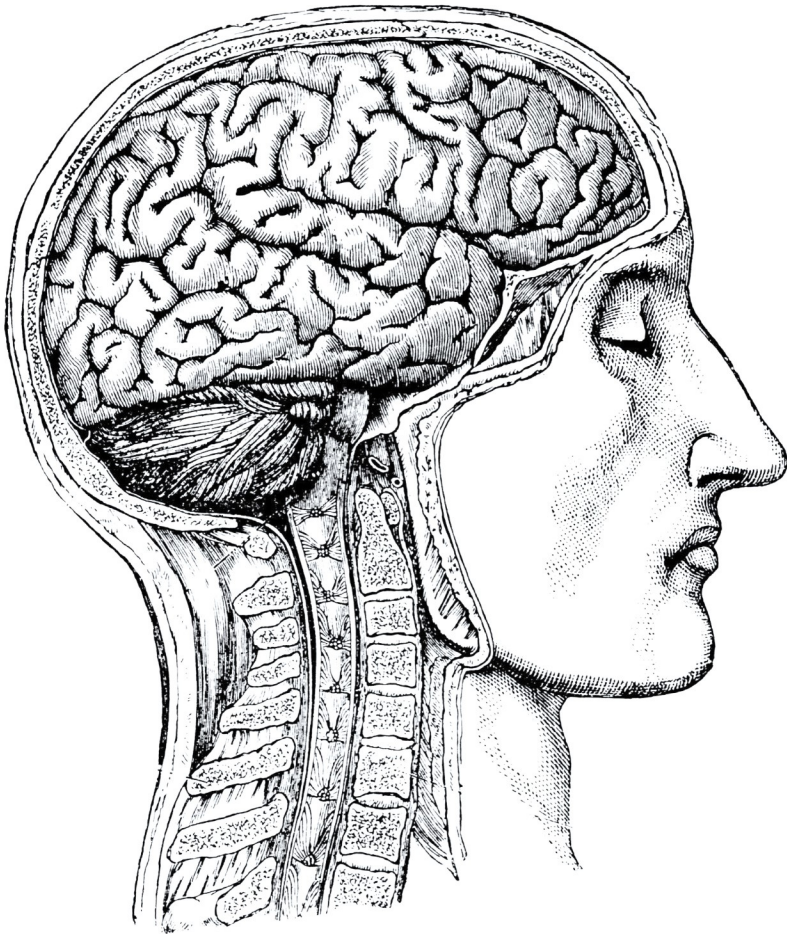


POSTCARD EMBROIDERY



WHAT YOU WILL NEED FOR THE SESSION

- A5 printed card
- Practice card
- A5 cardboard
- Embroidery needle
- Embroidery threads

POSTCARD EMBROIDERY

PREPARING YOUR CARD AND THREAD

STEP 1

Using your practice card, use a pencil to draw a simple shape, such as a curved line, a square or a letter.

STEP 2

With your card laid over your cardboard sheet included in the kit, use the pointed tip of your needle to perforate the line or shape you have just drawn, leaving equal 1-2cm spaces between each hole.

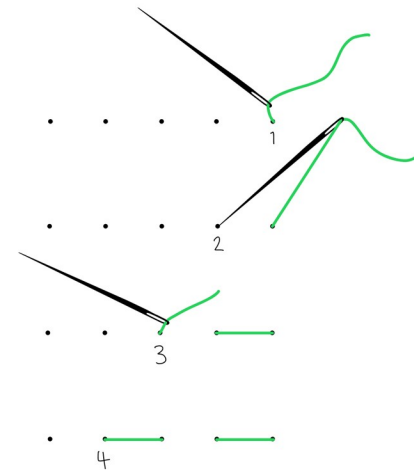
STEP 3

Once you have completed peircing your card, it's time to move onto the thread. Each thread contains six strands, which can be threaded as one for a bolder appearance, or separated for a finer line and crisper detail.

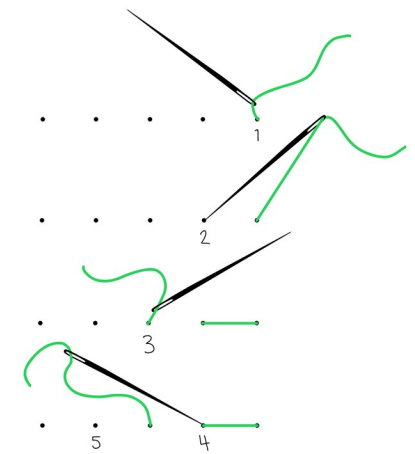
STEP 4

Once you have threaded your needle by guiding the strand(s) through the eye, the hole opposite the sharp tip of the needle, you will need to double knot THE loose end of your thred furthest from the needle.
